Forecast for Mon 01 Jul 2013 to Fri 05 Jul 2013

General Situation: Unsettled weather for much of the working week with a mix of dry and bright periods interspersed with cloudier, windier weather with rain affecting most regions at times through the period. Temperatures generally remaining close to average for early July. Becoming more settled and sunnier on Friday as high pressure becomes established across the United Kingdom.

Forecast for Sat 06 Jul 2013 to Mon 15 Jul 2013

General Situation: High pressure is expected to remain close to or over the British Isles. As a result, most areas will see fine and dry weather through the period. Daytime temperatures will be a little above average, especially in the sunnier parts of England. There are some signs of a return to cooler weather towards the middle of the month.

Forecast for Tue 16 Jul 2013 to Tue 30 Jul 2013

General Situation: Most indications are that the dry, settled weather will persist across most parts for at least some of the second half of the month. However, there is a chance of a return to cooler, more changeable conditions. On the whole, temperatures are likely to be around average over the second half of the month.
