



SIX RIGHTS AND DOUBLE CHECKS OF MEDICINES ADMINISTRATION

RIGHT PATIENT

Allergies/hypersensitivities/ADRs? Other medicines?

Clinical observations

RIGHT REASON

Indicated?

Contraindications? Cautions?

Consent?

RIGHT MEDICINE

Correct name and strength?

ALWAYS READ THE LABEL

In date?

Packaging intact and contents

are suitable for use?

RIGHT ROUTE

Can the medicine be given by the

route?

Is the route in your scope of

practice?

Is it suitable for the patient and

the reason for the medicine?

RIGHT DOSE

Check dose on the clinical

guideline.

Ensure you read the table

correctly.

RIGHT DOCUMENTATION

Enter ALL details of the medicine administered on the patient record. Where administered under a PGD or on a doctor's instruction, document it.

DOUBLE CHECKS

INDEPENDENT double check of medicine, dose, route and expiry.
Important for children <12yrs, injectable medicines, calculations and CDs.
